ORDER OF REVOCATION

Decision No. 74363, dated July 9, 1968, in Case No. 8759, ordered respondent Robertson to collect all undercharges revealed by the Commission investigation and to pay a fine of \$3,941.00 in addition to a punitive fine of \$500.

Robertson reported that the undercharges were collected, but he has failed to pay any part of the fines. He also owes \$623 in quarterly fees, which are the basis of a recently filed civil action. Robertson states he has no money to pay the fines and may be forced into bankruptcy. He has no assets in his name and is no longer operating, although he is an adviser in his sons' trucking business.

Findings of Fact

Based upon the record herein, the Commission finds that: 1. Robertson has failed to pay the fines imposed by Decision No. 74363.

2. Robertson has failed to pay \$623 in quarterly fees.

3. Robertson is no longer operating and has no equipment or assets.

The Commission concludes that the Robertson operating authority should be revoked and that the provisions of Decision No. 74363 should remain in full force and effect.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 20-682, issued to Shirley Robertson, be and it is revoked and canceled.

2. All of the provisions of Decision No. 74363 shall remain in full force and effect.

The Socretary of the Commission is directed to cause service of this order to be made on Shirley Robertson. This order shall be effective twenty days after the completion of service upon respondent Shirley Robertson.
