ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

By Decision No. 72535 dated June 6, 1967, in Application No. 49163, Venable Aircraft Co., a California corporation, doing business under the name of Valley Airways, was authorized to transport passengers as a passenger air carrier, as defined in Section 2741 of the California Public Utilities Code, between Hemet-Ryan Field, Redlands Municipal Airport and Los Angeles International Airport.

The carrier, by notice to the Commission dated May 23, 1968, advised the Commission of its intention to discontinue said passenger air carrier operations on May 31, 1968.


A staff review of the notice indicated that the carrier's scheduled passenger air service operations resulted in a loss of \$30,524.73, with operating ratio of 281.0 percent for the six months ending December 31, 1967.


The discontinuance of scheduled passenger air service by this carrier has been verified by the Commission staff. Venable Aircraft Co. continues to have insurance on file with this Commission to operate as a Commercial Air Operator pursuant to General Order No. 120-A.

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger air carrier operative rights created by the Decision No. 72535 in Application No. 49163 are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Venable Aircraft Co., doing business as Valley Airways, are hereby canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
