 authorizing construction of three new
 crossings at separated grades, and
 modification of an existing underpass
 in connection with the construction of
 Route 210 along and under the tracks
 of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe
 Railway Company referred to as SANTA
 ANITA UNDERPASS, BALDWIN AVENUE UNDER-
 PASS, MICHILLINDA AVENUE UNDERPASS
 and CHAPMAN UNDERPASS, in the City of
 Los Angeles.

O R D E R

State of California Department of Public Works, in con-
 nection with the construction of State Route 210, is hereby
 authorized to construct three crossings at separated grades and
 modify an existing underpass under the track of The Atchison, Topeka
 and Santa Fe Railway Company, in and near the City of Arcadia,
 Los Angeles County, at the locations and substantially as shown by
 plans (Exhibits A and B) attached to the application, and identified
 as follows:

- (a) Santa Anita Underpass, Crossing No. 2-124.9-B
- (b) Baldwin Avenue Underpass, Crossing No. 2-125.5-B
- (c) Michillinda Underpass, Crossing No. 2-126.5-B
- (d) Existing Chapman Underpass (Rosemead Boulevard),
 Crossing No. 2-126.3-B

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance
 with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative
 thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said

crossings approved by The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
