S U P P L E M E N T A L O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, having on November 12, 1968, requested that the Commission modify requirement No. 8, in Decision No. 71908, dated January 24, 1967, governing operations on its Los Angeles Division, the interested operating railroad brotherhoods being in accord that such modification is necessary and desirable, investigation by the staff of the Transportation Division having determined that operations can be conducted safely under the terms of said modifications, and it appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the request should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that requirement No. 8, in Decision No. 71908, dated January 24, 1967, governing operations on Southern Pacific Company's Los Angeles Division, is hereby amended to read:

- 8. Baldwin Park Branch. State Street to Bench - 52.99 Miles.
Movements shall be restricted to one at a time between Bench and M.P. 25 (west of San Dimas) and between Baldwin Park and State Street by the use of train registers located at Colton and Baldwin Park, respectively. Movements between Baldwin Park and M.P. 23 (east of Covina) (five miles) shall be made in accordance with Rule 93. Movements between M.P. 23 and M.P. 25 shall be made on train order authority only.

In all other respects Decision No. 71908, dated January 24, 1967, as amended by Decision No. 73658, dated January 30, 1968, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall be effective on the date hereof.
