ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Applicant has requested an extension of time within which to exercise the authority granted in Decision No. 74231, alleging that there have been unforeseen delays in consummating an agreement, but that it is anticipated that the Richmond passenger station will be replaced with a shelter within 90 days, and the removal of tracks and buildings and relocation of freight facilities will be accomplished within nine months.

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit within which applicant may exercise the authority granted in said decision is hereby extended to October 31, 1969, except that construction of the Richmond passenger shelter shall be completed by March 31, 1969.

In all other respects, Decision No. 74231 shall remain in full force and effect.
