BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the State of California Department of Public Works for an order authorizing construction of two crossings at separated grades and widening of one existing grade separation over the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company, in connection with the construction of an interchange between Routes 5 and 14, in the County of Los Angeles, referred to as "Route 14/5 Separation and Overhead", Bridge No. 53-1960 R; "South Connector Overcrossing", Bridge No. 53-1963; and "Weldon Canyon Overhead", Bridge No. 53-849.

O R D E R

State of California Department of Public Works, in connection with the construction of State Routes 5 and 14, is hereby authorized to construct two crossings at separated grades and modify an existing overhead over the track of Southern Pacific Company, near the City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, at the locations and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibits A and B) attached to the application, and identified as follows:

- (a) Route 14/5 Separation and Overhead, Bridge No. 53-1960 R, Crossing No. B-456.23-A.
- (b) South Connector Overcrossing, Bridge No. 53-1963, Crossing No. B-456.26-A.
- (c) Existing Weldon Canyon Overhead, Bridge No. 53-849, Crossing No. B-456.2-A.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossings approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with

the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 25-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within four years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
