SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision Nos. 74706 and 74885 dated September 24, 1968 and October 29, 1968, respectively, authorized the City of Los Angeles to construct a spur track at grade across the Wilmington-San Pedro Road in Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6MA-21.60-C.

The Southern Pacific Company, by letter dated November 26, 1968, has requested authorization to include additional flashing light signals on cantilever arms to the two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order 75-B) augmented with automatic gates ordered by Decision No. 74706.

The Board of Harbor Commissioners in behalf of the City of Los Angeles has requested a six month extension of time in which to install the automatic crossing protection, alleging an unforeseen shortage of labor and materials has delayed said installation.

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit within which the Harbor Belt Line Railroad may operate over the Wilmington-San Pedro Road

Crossing No. 6MA-21.60-C with interim protection by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material and under the other conditions set forth in Decision No. 74885, is hereby extended to June 30, 1969.

The permanent protection at the crossing shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) with additional flashing lights mounted on cantilever arms and augmented with automatic gates to be installed on or prior to June 30, 1969, instead of the permanent protection ordered in Decision No. 74706.

In all other respects Decisions Nos. 74706 and 74885 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
