OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 names minimum rates and rules for the statewide transportation of general commodities by highway carriers and provides, among other things, that the return transportation of empty pallets for distances not exceeding 75 miles may be performed without charge in connection with palletized shipments of specified commodities when such palletized shipments are subject to rates based on minimum weights of not less than 20,000 pounds.

By this petition, California Trucking Association seeks to have the aforementioned provisions of the above tariff amended to apply in connection with (1) palletized shipments of additional commodities and (2) palletized shipments of the currently specified commodities and the additional commodities when the rates governing such transportation are based on minimum weights of not less than 10,000 pounds.¹ Petitioner asks that all common carriers be

authorized to establish in their respective tariffs all such modifications as may be prescribed by the Commission's order in this proceeding, including relief from the long- and short-haul provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code.

Petitioner states that the provisions concerning the return transportation of empty pallets are experimental in nature and are expressly designed as an incentive to shippers to palletize their shipments and thus promote efficiencies and economies in carrier operations. Petitioner declares that these provisions reflect changes that were developed and proposed after joint shipper and carrier discussions and considerations and that the shippers and carriers have continued such discussions to the end of developing permanent provisions for the return transportation of empty pallets.

Petitioner alleges that, although such discussions are continuing, it is apparent that the sought changes are appropriate at this time and should not await any final determination concerning the nature of the permanent provisions. Petitioner avers that the proposed changes will not result in any increases in rates but rather will provide a further incentive for shipper cooperation in the palletization of truck shipments and will promote both efficiencies and economies in carrier operations. Petitioner asserts that its proposal is desired by, and in the interest of, both shippers and carriers.

Copies of the verified petition were mailed to various chambers of commerce, shipper organizations and carrier representatives on or about November 11, 1968. The petition was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of November 14, 1968. No objection to the granting of the petition has been received.

In the circumstances, it appears and the Commission finds that petitioner's proposal is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the petition should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 (Appendix D to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective February 22, 1969, the revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A, also attached hereto, which pages and appendix are by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the amendments authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendments published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty-four days after the date hereof.
