O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct a track at grade across Montezuma Street and Railroad Avenue East in the Town of Macdoel, Siskiyou County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of existing Grade Crossing No. CF-396.7. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding four percent. Protection shall be by four additional Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material, with two of the aforementioned signs placed so as to protect traffic on Railroad Avenue East. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
