A petition for rehearing of Decision No. 74888 has been filed by Arrowhead Manor Water Company. The Commission is also of the opinion that the proceedings in Application No. 49895 should be reopened for the limited purpose of determining whether newly acquired utility plant should be included in applicant's rate base and whether applicant is thus entitled to an increase in its rates. ✓
