O P I N I O N

Village Water Company and Orbis Water Company request an order of the Commission authorizing them to execute a document consisting of a Supplemental Indenture, Agreement of Assumption, Supplemental Mortgage and Amendment of Security Agreement.

By Decision No. 74898, dated November 6, 1968, as supplemented by Decision No. 75196, dated January 14, 1969, in Application No. 50463, the Commission authorized Orbis Water Company to transfer its water system to Village Water Company. In connection with said transfer the Commission authorized applicants to enter into an agreement providing for the assumption by the latter of obligations of the former to Pacific Mutual Life Insurance Company.

For the purpose of amending previously authorized encumbering documents so as to conform with said agreement, applicants propose to execute a document similar to that which is attached to the present application as Exhibit C.

After consideration the Commission finds that the proposed document will not be adverse to the public interest. On the basis of this finding we conclude that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Village Water Company and Orbis Water Company may execute and deliver a document in the same form, or in substantially the same form, as that filed in this proceeding as Exhibit C and referred to in the application as Supplemental Indenture No. 1.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
