ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

Air California filed a complaint seeking an order restraining Pacific Southwest Airlines (PSA) from taking reservations and selling tickets for passenger air carrier service between San Diego-Long Beach and San Francisco after January 10, 1969. The authority to conduct such passenger air carrier service granted to PSA by Decision No. 75015, dated November 26, 1968, expired January 10, 1969. Decision No. 75188, dated January 8, 1969, denied PSA's petition for an extension of said authority. PSA has in fact discontinued taking reservations or selling tickets for passenger air service between San Diego-Long Beach and San Francisco after January 10, 1969. The relief sought by Complaint No. 8882 is moot. Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Complaint No. 8882 is hereby dismissed.
