ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR PAYMENT OF FINE

Commission Decision No. 74068, issued herein May 7, 1968, ordered the respondent to pay a fine of \$9,315.53 on or before July 10, 1968. Decision No. 74607, dated August 27, 1968, extended the time within which the fine was to be paid to January 1, 1969.

Respondent has advised by letter that it has no funds to pay the fine but that it has filed suit to collect the undercharges due. It requests that a reasonable extension of time be granted to enable it to pursue the available legal remedy and to effect collection of the undercharges.

IT IS ORDERED that the time within which respondent Zebra Trucking is ordered to pay the sum of \$9,315.53 pursuant to paragraph one of the order in Decision No. 74068, dated May 7, 1968, in Case No. 8733, is extended to June 1, 1969.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
