ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 72067 dated February 28, 1967, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (Pacific) was authorized to sell and convey to the City of Lompoc (City) certain electric distribution facilities located in the area known as Badger Annexation No. 33 to the City of Lompoc. The decision states that the authority granted shall expire in the event that City does not consummate the purchase of this property within two years after date of the decision.

Pacific, by petition filed January 31, 1969, requests an extension of time to and including February 28, 1970 to consummate the sale. The petition states that City has informed Pacific that it will not be able to consummate the purchase by the expiration date of the Commission's authorization because it has not yet obtained the necessary dedications of property for rights-of-way on which to install the connecting facilities. City is in the process of acquiring rights-of-way and when this is completed it will be in a position to proceed with the construction of the new facilities to take the load.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the requested extension of time should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that the time for consummation of the authority granted by Decision No. 72067 is extended to and including February 28, 1970.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
