ORDER GRANTING REHEARING

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, having filed a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 74917, and the Commission having considered said petition and each and every allegation therein, and being of the opinion that rehearing should be granted,

IT IS ORDERED that the above entitled proceedings are reopened for the limited purpose of receiving additional testimony as to the adequacy of the amount of the \$2,000,000 increase to Pacific's subscribers ordered for the purpose of implementing I-I toll settlements, such additional testimony to present the 1967 effect of I-I toll, orally, by exhibit or by stipulation; and for the further limited purpose of hearing oral argument before the Commission in bank.

Until final disposition herein, all of the provisions of Decision No. 74917 shall remain in effect.

Said rehearing shall be held before the Commission in bank in the Commission's Courtroom, State Building, San Francisco, California, on APR 9 - 1969, 1969 at 10 a.m.
