ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By Decisions Nos. 74449, 74450, 74451, 74452 and 74453 dated July 23, 1968, in the above proceedings, the Commission set forth interim exception ratings in Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 to govern the rates in various Commission minimum rate tariffs.¹

By Orders Setting Hearing, Decision No. 74992 dated November 26, 1968, in Cases Nos. 5435, 5439 and 5441, the Commission ordered that hearings in those proceedings be held concurrently with the hearings in Cases Nos. 5432 and 7858 concerning final disposition of the aforementioned exception ratings.

Inasmuch as these exception ratings are being considered by the Commission in the above-mentioned proceedings, disposition of such matters in the instant proceedings is no longer necessary. In the circumstances, the petitions in the instant proceedings should be dismissed.

The tariffs are Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B and City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A (currently Minimum Rate Tariff 19).

IT IS ORDERED that Petitions for Modification Nos. 40, 107, 76 and 146 in Cases Nos. 7858, 5435, 5439 and 5441, respectively, are dismissed.
