ORDER MODIFYING DECISION

Defendant,

Ordering paragraph l.c. of Decision No. 73410, dated November 28, 1967, in C-8666 required defendant, by February 29, 1968, to connect with 6-inch main Well No. 3 at 4219 Warda Avenue to the existing 4-inch water main on Esmail Avenue as shown on Exhibit No. 3 of that proceeding. Decision No. 73869 dated March 19, 1968, provides an extension of time to and including June 1, 1969 for compliance with this ordering paragraph.

By letter received February 25, 1969 the utility states that the installation of this main was for the purpose of looping the water system and is not necessary as its new well is presently furnishing an adequate amount of water to the general area. The utility instead proposes to replace with a 6-inch main an existing and inadequate 3-inch main between Well No. 3 and the corner of Seventh Street and Lucinda Avenue. The utility states this new installation will produce better utilization of Well No. 3. The utility's proposal has been evaluated by the engineers of our staff who find the proposed changes reasonable.

The Commission having considered the utility's proposal and finding no objection to it, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

Paragraph l.c. of Decision No. 73410 is modified to read

as follows:

"By June 1, 1969, have connected with 6-inch main Well No. 3 at 4219 Warda Avenue to the existing 4-inch water main located at Seventh Street and Lucinda Avenue."
