LA MIRADA AND THE COUNTY

INTERIM ORDER

County of Los Angeles is hereby authorized to widen the crossing of Valley View Avenue at grade across the tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, identified as Crossing No. 2-158.4, in the Cities of Santa Fe Springs and La Mirada and Los Angeles County, as described and substantially as shown in the application. Width of crossing shall be not less than 84 feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) augmented with automatic gate arms. Backlights may be omitted from the signals to be mounted on the center medians. Such protection shall be placed in service before the alteration work is completed and the crossing is fully opened to vehicular traffic. No obstructions shall be placed near the flashing light signals which will impair the motorists' view.

Construction expense of the crossing shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties

or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission.

The County of Los Angeles shall advance to The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company the sum of \$35,537.00, which sum shall be used by The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company to install the protection and improve the crossing as specified herein.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
