Investigation into the status, safety, maintenance, use and protection or closing of various crossings at grade of the lines of Southern Pacific Company, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, Union Pacific Railroad Company and Pacific Electric Railway Company in the County of San Bernardino, California, with various streets, roads and highways, in said county.

ORDER EXTENDING TIME

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company has requested an extension of time within which to comply with certain conditions of Decisions Nos. 72106, 74276 and 75167, alleging that it will be impossible to complete the upgrading of protection at two crossings ordered in said decisions within the time specified.

The railway seeks, due to recent storm damage, an extension of time to June 30, 1969 for completion of protection at the following crossings:

IT IS ORDERED that the time limits within which the railway shall complete the project listed above are hereby extended to June 30, 1969.

In all other respects Decision No. 72106 as amended shall remain in full force and effect.
