SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 75435, dated March 18, 1969, defendant Pacific Telephone Company was ordered to reduce its claimed charges as of August 23, 1968, against Lange Industries, Inc., Finlandia Sauna Repair Service, and Ambassador Sauna from \$2,683.32, as set forth in Exhibit No. 22, by the amount of \$623.73 to the amount of \$2,059.59.

It appears that the amount of \$623.73 is 50 percent of all yellow pages directory advertising by complainant for 1967-1968 Compton, Inglewood, and San Pedro directories, and 100 percent for the erroneous directory advertising in the Beverly Hills directory. Since the alleged delinquencies for Compton, Inglewood, and San Pedro included all types of directory advertising and only the Ambassador Sauna display ad was in error by the omission

of the city of Anaheim in complainant's address, the correct adjustment should be \$387.00 instead of \$623.73.

Good cause appearing, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 1.a. of Decision No. 75435 be corrected and that Pacific Telephone Company shall adjust the account of Clifford B. Lange, as set forth in Exhibit No. 22, by reducing the claimed charges as of August 23, 1968, against Lange Industries, Inc., Finlandia Sauna Repair Service, and Ambassador Sauna from \$2,683.32 by the amount of \$387.00 to the amount of \$2,296.32.

In all other respects, Decision No. 75435 is affirmed.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
