ORDER REOPENING CASES NOS. 5098 AND 7192

It appearing that General Order No. 98-A was adopted by Decision No. 69331 in Cases Nos. 5098 and 7192; and

It further appearing that Commission General Order No. 98-A contains rules concerning identification of equipment operated by charter-party carriers of passengers subject to the Commission's jurisdiction; and

It further appearing that it may be in the public interest to add provisions to General Order No. 98-A concerning identification of motor vehicles operated by charter-party carriers of passengers; and

It further appearing that charter-party carriers of passengers subject to the Commission's jurisdiction, hereby made respondents, are necessary and indispensable parties hereto; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Cases Nos. 5098 and 7192 are reopened for the following purposes:

1. To determine whether the public interest requires the adding of provisions to General Order No. 98-A concerning identification of motor vehicles operated by charter-party carriers of passengers.

2. To enter any other order that may be appropriate in the lawful exercise of the Commission's jurisdiction.

Public hearing in said cases shall be held before such Commissioner or Examiner as may be designated, at a time and place hereafter to be set.

The Secretary is directed to cause certified copies of this order to be served forthwith upon each charter-party carrier of passengers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission, and to cause appropriate notice of hearing to be mailed at least ten (10) days before such hearing to said parties.
