ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Applicant Charter Sedan Service, a corporation, requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate a scheduled passenger stage corporation over a fixed route between the San Jose Municipal Airport and City of Palo Alto, with intermediate stopping places in the City of Sunnyvale, City of Mountain View and the Village of Los Altos.

After receiving notice that the applicant had been adjudicated bankrupt on June 5, 1968, and after protests were filed by Peninsula Transit Lines and National Executive Services, Inc., the matter was set for hearing on March 18, 1969. On that date the applicant informed the Commission that he was withdrawing the application and that he would not appear at the hearing.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the application is dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
