OPINION

Applicants request a certificate of public convenience and necessity to establish and operate a service under Section 1031 et. seq., of the Public Utilities Code for the transportation of passengers as a tour service in and around the City of Santa Cruz, visiting such points of interest as Henry Cowell State Park, University of California at Santa Cruz, National Bridges State Park, The Boardwalk, various motels within the area and other points of natural interest.

Initially the applicants intend to operate the tour service during the months of May, June, July, August and September.

The proposed fares for a three-hour tour as described on attached map (Exhibit "A") will be \$5.00 for each adult and \$3.00 for children under ten years of age. Departure times will be twice daily. The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar on January 27, 1969.

There are no protests to the application.

A statement of applicants' financial condition as shown by Exhibit B attached to the application indicates a net worth of \$134,940.65.

Norman W. Richardson and Janet M. Richardson, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the decision noted in the margin, are authorized to transport passengers for sightseeing purposes between the City of Santa Cruz, on the one hand, and the Boardwalk, Historical Wax Museum, Lighthouse Point, Natural Bridges State Park, Santa Cruz Campus of University of California, Santa Cruz Mission, Henry Cowell State Park, Santa Vida's Leprechaum Woods, Twin Lakes Beach State Park and the Art Gallery and Last Supper and intermediate points, on the other hand, subject to the following conditions and restrictions:

- (a) All service herein authorized shall be limited to the transportation of round-trip passengers only.
- (b) Service shall be operated from May 1 to September 30.
- (c) Operations shall be conducted over the most suitable streets and highways subject to local traffic regulations.
