ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By letter filed April 15, 1969, The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company seeks an extension of time within which to comply with that portion of Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 74917 (issued November 6, 1968 in this matter) relating to COM PAK service associated with tariff schedule 22-T, Key Equipment Service, as described in Appendix A to said decision. Certain conversions of equipment require field modifications to be made and the magnitude of the task now appears to be greater than that originally anticipated. Applicant now states that completion of the work involved will require additional time and estimates completion, by stages, during the months of September, October and November of 1969.
