ORDER TERMINATING PROCEEDING

By Decision No. 74000, dated April 16, 1968, California Department of Public Works was authorized to construct crossings of State Route 87 at separated grades over tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and of Southern Pacific Company in the City and County of San Francisco.

Said decision provided that if the parties should fail to agree as to apportionment of construction and maintenance costs the matter would be made the subject of a further order of the Commission. It appearing at the time of issuance of Decision No. 74000 that there might be a difference of opinion among the parties which would require additional hearings, the matter, at the request of one of the parties, was kept on the Commission's calendar. The application was taken off calendar on January 28, 1969, on receipt of written advice from applicant that agreement had been reached as to apportionment of costs and that the matter might be closed out.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the proceeding in Application No. 49626, as amended, is terminated.
