FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 72383, dated May 2, 1967, the State of California, Department of Public Works was granted authority to construct Pocket Road (Meadowview Road) at grade across a track of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County. Two of the conditions of the decision are that the width of the crossing shall be not less than thirty feet and that crossing protection shall be by two Standard No. 3 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic gate arms. This crossing has since been constructed.

By correspondence dated January 22, 1969, applicant now requests that authority be granted to complete the final phase of the project by widening of the crossing to four 12-foot traffic lanes with left-turn lanes and acceleration lanes as set forth in Exhibit "C" of the original application to be protected by four Standard No. 3 crossing signals supplemented with automatic gate arms.

Copy of agreement between railroad and applicant having been filed and investigation having been made by the Commission staff, it appears that applicant's request should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 72383 is modified to contain this additional paragraph following the second paragraph on page 1 thereof:

Upon the further widening of the crossing to not less than ninety-two feet with level grades of approach, protection shall be by four Standard No. 2 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic gate arms.

In all other respects Decision No. 72383 shall remain in full force and effect except that time limit within which applicant may exercise the authority granted herein shall expire if not exercised within two years from the date hereof.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
