SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 names minimum rates and rules for the statewide transportation of general commodities by highway carriers. Among other things, the tariff exempts from the application of the rates named therein the transportation of property between specific points and within certain defined metropolitan areas and sets forth provisions governing the free return transportation of empty pallets.

It has come to the Commission's attention that the name of one of the aforementioned specific points has been changed and that certain provisions pertaining to the transportation of pallets are redundant.¹

¹ Item No. 30(g) of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 provides that the rates named in said tariff are not applicable to the transportation of property between points in a defined metropolitan Fresno area and the adjacent plant of Pittsburgh Plate Glass Company. The company has changed its corporate name to PPG Industries, Inc. Item No. 45 of Tariff No. 2 contains the provisions governing the free return transportation of empty pallets and indicates that such provisions apply in connection with palletized shipments of commodities described in Items No. 316, 320, 320-1, 335.5, 338, 345, 350, 360, 390 and 654½ of said tariff. Except for Items Nos. 335.5 and 654½, certain provisions in these other items are redundant inasmuch as they are also set forth in Item No. 45.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the necessary corrections should be made by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 should be amended accordingly.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 (Appendix "D" to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein to become effective July 5, 1969, the revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A, also attached hereto, which pages and appendix are made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order. Tariff publications authorized herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the tariff provisions authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the tariff provisions published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects, Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty-four days after the date hereof.
