ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

By Decision No. 72097 dated February 28, 1967, in Application No. 49062, Mammoth Bus Lines, Inc. was authorized to acquire a passenger stage operative right authorizing service between the Town of Mammoth Lakes and the Mammoth Mountain Ski Lift and intermediate points, and it appearing that during the month of January, 1968, Mammoth Bus Lines, Inc., without appropriate authority, discontinued the passenger stage service theretofore conducted by it between the Town of Mammoth Lakes and the Mammoth Mountain Ski Lift pursuant to the foregoing described operative right, and that since April 22, 1968, Mammoth Bus Lines, Inc. has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order No. 101-3; and therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage operative rights, created by Decision No. 72097 in Application No. 49062, are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Mammoth Bus Lines, Inc. are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to mail a certified copy of this order to Mammoth Bus Lines, Inc., attention of Mr. Base C. Ferebee, President at Manzanita Trailer Park, Mammoth Lake, CA 93546, last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after the above mailing to Mammoth Bus Lines, Inc., unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
