In the Matter of the Application of the City of Los Angeles, a municipal corporation, by and through its Board of Harbor Commissioners, for authority to construct, operate and maintain an additional industry spur track across New Dock Street, a private roadway in the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State of California, under the management, supervision and control of the Board of Harbor Commissioners, and to remove certain existing tracks.)

O R D E R

The City of Los Angeles, a municipal corporation, by and through its Board of Harbor Commissioners, is hereby authorized to construct, operate and maintain two industrial tracks at grade across New Dock Street in Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 3A-25.71-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Upon completion of Crossing No. 3A-25.71-C and its opening to public use, the existing crossings Nos. 3A-24.40-C, 3A-24.97-C, and 3A-24.96-C, located 1300, 2800, and 3200 feet, respectively, to the east, shall be abandoned and physically removed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant requests that this authority be made effective immediately.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
