ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Applicant has requested an extension of time within which to exercise the authority granted in Decision No. 74019, alleging that construction of the project has not been completed but that it is anticipated that the project will be completed within one year. The crossing is identified as Nadeau Street, Crossing No. BG-488.9.

Applicant has also requested authority to omit the backlights on the lower set of lights mounted on the mast of the Standard No. 8 flashing light signal supplemented by similar flashing lights on a cantilevered arm located in the southwesterly quadrant of said crossing.

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit within which applicant may exercise the authority granted in said decision is extended to April 23, 1970. Backlights may be omitted from the lower set of lights on the signal in the southwesterly quadrant of Crossing No. BG-488.9.

In all other respects Decision No. 74019 is in full force and effect.
