THIRD ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 71971, dated February 7, 1967, as amended, in Case No. 3438, the Commission ordered, among other things, the installation of automatic gates by December 31, 1968, at Alabama Street (Crossing No. 2U-7.3) on The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in the City of Redlands, San Bernardino County.

By letter dated April 3, 1969 the city has requested an additional extension of time to complete the widening of the crossing and installation of automatic crossing protection.

IT IS ORDERED that the completion date for the installation of the automatic gates at Alabama Street (Crossing No. 2U-7.3) is hereby extended to December 31, 1969.

In all other respects, Decision No. 71971 shall remain in full force and effect.
