 authorizing the construction of
 College Blvd. crossing, tentatively
 designated as Crossing 2E-5.6, across
 the Escondido Branch of the Atchison,
 Topeka and Santa Fe Railway, within
 the City of Oceanside.

ORDER

City of Oceanside is hereby authorized to construct College Boulevard at grade across a track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in Oceanside, San Diego County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 2E-5.6.

Width of crossing shall be not less than 32 feet and grades of approach not greater than 6.0 percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Applicant shall bear entire expense of construction and installation of automatic protection, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines. Maintenance costs of the automatic protection shall be borne by the applicant, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
