ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Applicant has requested an extension of time within which to exercise the authority granted in Decision No. 71898 for the construction of Linda Vista Street (Crossing No. 2B-41.5) across the tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in Orange County alleging that it has been informed that the railway will experience delays in completion of the installation of the crossing protection and necessary track work and planking and that it is anticipated that the project will be completed in one year.

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit within which applicant may exercise the authority granted in said decision is hereby extended to January 24, 1970.

In all other respects Decision No. 71898 is in full force and effect.
