ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

By Decision No. 73613 dated January 9, 1968, in Application No. 49532, Golden West Airlines, Inc., a California corporation, was authorized to transport passengers as a passenger air carrier, as defined in Section 2741 of the California Public Utilities Code, between points in California. The authority was subsequently modified by Decisions Nos. 74325 and 75067 and by Resolution No. PE 15.

Pursuant to Section 2769.5 of the California Public Utilities Code, Golden West Airlines, Inc. advised the Commission and other parties by letter of April 11, 1969 of its intention to discontinue its passenger air carrier operation on May 10, 1969. Golden West Airlines has now discontinued all passenger air carrier operations.

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger air carrier operative rights created by the Decision No. 73613 in Application No. 49532 and, as subsequently modified, are hereby revoked and all effective

tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Golden West Airlines, Inc., are hereby canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
