O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct an industrial drill track at grade across Stimson Avenue in the City of Industry, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BKA-512.3-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 2.5 percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic gates. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Trains shall not be operated over the crossing until such protection is placed in service.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. Applicant alleges that the crossing is needed to provide immediate service to the industry.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
