ORDER FURTHER AMENDING DECISION NO. 73402

Ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 73402, dated November 28, 1967, in Case No. 8623, directed respondent Kahn to pay a fine of \$750 in six equal monthly installments of \$125 each. Said decision was amended by Decision No. 73872, dated March 19, 1968, which authorized said respondent to pay the fine in 15 monthly installments of \$50 each, commencing May 1, 1968. He has paid \$350 toward the fine but has not paid any of the eight remaining installments. Attempts to collect the balance of the fine have been unsuccessful. Respondent Kahn's present whereabouts are unknown. All operating authority held by him lapsed and terminated on January 23, 1968. In the circumstances:

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The balance of \$400 due on the fine imposed on respondent Kahn by ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 73402, as amended, is hereby waived.

2. No new household goods carrier permit or other operating authority shall be issued to or held by respondent Kahn, as an individual, or any partnership, association or corporation in which said respondent is financially interested, unless, as a condition precedent thereto, said respondent has agreed to the rescission of the waiver referred to in ordering paragraph 1 hereof and has paid the \$400 balance in full.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
