ORDER DISCONTINUING INVESTIGATION

By an order of suspension and investigation, issued September 17, 1968, certain tariff sheets of General Telephone Company of California, filed under Advice Letter No. 2069, were suspended until December 16, 1968, pending public hearing and further order of the Commission.

By Decision No. 75081, dated December 10, 1968, the operation and effectiveness of the tariff sheets filed by General's Advice Letter No. 2069 were suspended for an additional period of six months to and including June 16, 1969, unless otherwise ordered.

By letter dated June 3, 1969, General requested withdrawal of the filing without prejudice and also requested that Advice Letter No. 2069 and the tariff sheets transmitted therewith be permanently suspended.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The operation and effectiveness of the tariff sheets filed by General Telephone Company of California's Advice Letter No. 2069 are permanently suspended.
2. Case No. 8846 is discontinued.
