## ORDER FURTHER EXTENDING TIME TO PAY FINE

By Decision No. 72975, dated August 29, 1967, respondent was directed to collect \$5,113.11 in undercharges and to pay a fine in the amount of said undercharges plus a \$2,000 pumitive fine. The total amount of the fine was \$7,113.11. Respondent was authorized by Decision No. 73677, dated January 30, 1968, to pay the balance then owing on said fine in monthly installments of \$200 each. The balance now remaining to be paid is \$1,790.13.

By letter dated May 31, 1969, respondent's attorney stated that \$2,467.45 in undercharges ordered to be collected by said Decision No. 72975 has not as yet been paid by the shipper involved; that he has obtained a judgment against the shipper for said amount; and that he is experiencing difficulty in collecting the judgment. Respondent's attorney requests that payment of the remaining installments be deferred for a reasonable period to allow sufficient time to effect collection of the judgment.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The time within which the next installment is due on the fine imposed on respondent by Decision No. 72975, as amended, is hereby extended to and including August 29, 1969.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
