O P I N I O N

The United States of America, represented by the Commander, Naval Facilities Engineering Command, acting under the direction of the Secretary of the Navy, requests authority to construct a pedestrian overpass across the rights of way of The Atchison, Topeka, and Santa Fe Railway Company and the San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company in the vicinity of Harbor Drive and 32nd Street, San Diego, California.

It is alleged that the property on both sides of the railroads' rights of way is owned by the United States and that the proposed pedestrian overpass is necessary for safe pedestrian access to the main portion of the Naval Station from newly constructed barracks buildings. It is further alleged that the railroads have no objection to the construction of the pedestrian overpass.

After consideration the Commission finds that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. After the effective date hereof the United States of America as represented by the Department of the Navy may construct a pedestrian overpass across the rights of way of The Atchison, Topeka and

Santa Fe Railway Company and the San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company in accordance with the easements and plans as set forth in exhibits attached to the application.

2. All costs of construction and maintenance of said overpass shall be paid by applicant.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
