## OPINION AND ORDER

Telfer Tank Lines, Inc., a corporation, holds a petrolcum contract carrier permit. Decision No. 74105 dated May 14, 1968, in Application No. 50120, extended for thirteen months its authority to transport liquid asphalt and road oils in tank truck equipment, from the refinery of Shell Oil Company at Martinez to Pleasanton and Framont for Industrial Asphalt, Inc., at rates less than the Commission's established minimum rates. The current rate authority is scheduled to expire on July 1, 1969.

Applicant requests herein that the authority granted by Decision No. 74105 be extended to July 1, 1970 and that the authorized rates be respectively increased from \$2.25 and \$2.65 to \$2.35 and \$2.75 per ton for transportation to Pleasanton and Fremont, and that the increased rates be made to expire with July 1, 1970.

According to applicant, movements of the above commodities between the points in question have occurred on an average of four days per week and three to nine truckloads have been hauled on such days. Applicant states that it has experienced excellent utilization of its equipment inasmuch as the loading and unloading facilities have been made available on a 24-hour day basis.
