## BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the State of California  
 Department of Public Works for an order  
 authorizing construction of one crossing  
 at separated grades in the County of  
 Los Angeles, whereby State Route 14 will  
 be carried over the main line tracks of  
 the Southern Pacific Company, referred  
 to as HUMPHREYS OVERHEAD.

O R D E R

State of California Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to construct a crossing at separated grades of State Route 14 over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, near Solemint, Los Angeles County, at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit A & B) attached to the application, to be identified as Humphreys Overhead, Crossing No. B-443.4-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall be in accordance with General Order 26-D, except that during the period of construction a clearance of not less than 21' 0" above top of rail is authorized and Southern Pacific Company is authorized to operate with such reduced overhead clearance provided it issues, and files with the Commission, appropriate bulletins to train and engine crews advising them of the

temporarily impaired clearance condition and forbidding trainmen to ride on the tops of cars while operating beneath the structure. Applicant shall notify the Commission and Southern Pacific Company at least 15 days but not more than 30 days in advance of the date when the temporary impaired clearance will be created.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
