O R D E R

State of California Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to construct a crossing at separated grades of State Route 50 over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibits "B" and "C") attached to the application, as amended, to be identified as Crossing No. D-133.2-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Clearances shall be in conformance with General Order No. 26-D, except that during the period of construction, a clearance of not less than 21'0" above tops of rail is authorized and Southern Pacific Company is authorized to operate with such reduced overhead

clearance provided it issues, and files with the Commission, appropriate bulletins to train and engine crews advising them of the temporarily impaired clearance condition and forbidding trainmen to ride on the tops of cars while operating beneath the structure.

Applicant shall notify the Commission and Southern Pacific Company at least 15 days but not more than 30 days in advance of the date when the temporary impaired clearance will be created.

Upon opening to traffic of the grade separation authorized herein, existing grade Crossing No. AH-94.8, Brighton Avenue, approximately 200 feet southeasterly, shall be abolished by physical closing by Southern Pacific Company.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
