SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

So-Cal Motor Freight, a corporation, (formerly known as Southern California Freight Lines) is a highway common carrier operating under a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission. C. J. Boddington, Vice President-Traffic, of So-Cal Motor Freight, has submitted to this Commission certified copies of certificate of amendment of articles of incorporation, filed with the Secretary of State, changing its corporate name to Hopper Truck Lines. Accordingly, the certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name. The carrier will also be ordered to amend its tariffs pursuant to General Order No. 80-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 64404, dated October 16, 1962, as amended by Decision No. 74375, dated July 9, 1968, in Application No. 43636, as amended by Decision No. 71069, dated August 2, 1966, in Application No. 48504, is further amended by substituting "Hopper Truck Lines" in place and stead of So-Cal Motor Freight."

2. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, Hopper Truck Lines shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule 6.4 of General Order No. 80-A.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
