## OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 71490, dated November 1, 1966, in Application No. 48157, granted a passenger air carrier certificate to D. W. Mercer, doing business as Mercer Enterprises, authorizing service between Burbank, Long Beach and San Diego. This application has been filed to transfer the operating authority from an individual to a corporation. There will be no change in facilities, equipment, personnel or operations. It is alleged that Mercer incorporated to provide better business management and more efficient operation. A certified copy of the Articles of Incorporation of Mercer Enterprises is attached to the application.

The certificate and tariffs will be amended to show the new corporate name. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Decision No. 71490, dated November 1, 1966, in Application No. 48157, is amended by substituting "Mercer Enterprises" in place and stead of D. W. Mercer, wherever the latter name appears.
