On June 2, 1969, complainant filed a complaint against Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Co. (Pacific) alleging the negligence of Pacific in failing to list complainant's business number in the Yellow Pages of the telephone directory, and therefore requested damages from Pacific for such negligence resulting in the loss of business.

On June 17, 1969, a letter was received from Pacific informing the Commission that a settlement had been agreed upon between the respective parties. Also on June 17, 1969, a request for dismissal without prejudice was filed by the complainant. Therefore, the complaint should be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that the complaint in Case No. 8922 is hereby dismissed.
