INTERIM ORDER

The State of California Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to reconstruct the crossing of State Route No. 37 at grade with a track of Southern Pacific Company, Crossing No. AAB-64.3, in Vallejo, Solano County, as described and substantially as shown in the application. Width of crossing shall be not less than 65 feet wide with grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 3 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) augmented with automatic gate arms.

Construction expense of the crossing shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.

Installation cost of the automatic crossing protection shall be divided equally between the applicant and the railroad.

The parties are not in agreement as to sharing or apportionment of the maintenance costs of the automatic signal protection to be provided at the crossing upon exercise of the authority granted

herein and have agreed that this maintenance cost be apportioned by further order of the Commission.

The widened portion of crossing shall not be opened to public use until the protection ordered herein is installed and operative.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
