ORDER DENYING TEMPORARY RESTRAINING
 ORDER AND SETTING HEARING

Complainant Air California filed its complaint herein on July 21, 1969, alleging certain unlawful operations on the part of defendant Pacific Southwest Airlines. Complainant prayed for issuance of an ex parte order temporarily restraining defendant from conducting the alleged unlawful operations.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED:

1. The request for an ex parte order is denied
2. The public interest requires hearing in this matter on less than ten days' notice.
3. Hearing in this matter is set before Commissioner Vukasin and/or Examiner Barnett, at the Commission courtroom in Los Angeles at 10:00 a.m. Thursday July 31, 1969.
4. Defendant Pacific Southwest Airlines shall, on or before the time set for hearing herein file its answer to the complaint.

5 The Commission staff is authorized to participate as a party in this proceeding.

The Secretary is directed to accomplish immediate service of the complaint and a copy of this order upon defendant Pacific Southwest Airlines.
