SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 74330, as amended by Decisions Nos. 75344 and 75666, ordered respondents Theodore R. Arnold, Elwood M. Bobo, George F. Hellen, Walter P. Henricksen, Kenneth Henricksen and Franklin F. Steele to cease and desist operating a passenger stage service to and from the San Francisco Bay Naval Shipyard at Mare Island, on or before July 31, 1969, unless an application is filed and a certificate of public convenience and necessity is obtained from the Commission authorizing such operations.

Applications for certificates of public convenience and necessity to operate as passenger stage corporations having been filed and it appearing that decisions in such applications will not be effective on or before July 31, 1969,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The time within which Theodore R. Arnold, Elwood M. Bobo, George F. Hellen, Walter P. Henricksen, Kenneth Henricksen and Franklin F. Steele must comply with Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 74330, as amended by Decisions Nos. 75344 and 75666, is hereby extended to December 31, 1969.

2. In all other respects Decision No. 74330, as amended by Decisions Nos. 75344 and 75666, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
