SECOND INTERIM ORDER

Application No. 49980 is one in which The Gray Line Tours Company (hereinafter called Gray Line) seeks authority to serve an area in Inglewood known as The Forum from various areas in Southern California. The Commission, in Decision No. 74421, previously granted Gray Line interim authority to render such service. The interim authority expired on March 1, 1969.

On July 29, 1969, Gray Line filed a petition seeking authority to enable it to serve the Ringling Brothers Circus which will be at The Forum from July 30, 1969 until August 11, 1969. The Commission has considered the averments in the verified Petition For Further Temporary Authority and makes the following findings and conclusion.

Findings of Fact

1. A public hearing on the petition is not necessary.
2. Public convenience and necessity require that Gray Line be granted temporary authority to serve the Ringling Brothers Circus at The Forum as hereinafter provided.

Conclusion of Law

Gray Line should be granted temporary authority to serve The Forum from various areas in Southern California at the rates indicated.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Gray Line Tours Company is hereby awarded a temporary certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation for the purpose only of conducting express passenger bus service from the following territories, as defined in Items Nos. 100, 105, 110, 115, 120, 125, 130, 135, 140, 145, 150, 160, 165, 170, 180 and 185 of Appendix A of Decision No. 61715, Beverly Hills Territory, Burbank Territory, Colton Territory, Culver City Territory, Disneyland Territory, Eagle Rock Territory, Glendale Territory, Hollywood Territory, Long Beach Territory, Los Angeles Territory, North Hollywood Territory, Pasadena Territory, Riverside Territory, San Bernardino Territory, Santa Monica Territory and Westwood Village Territory, on the one hand, and all points adjacent to The Forum, Inglewood, California, necessary and convenient to discharging and picking up passengers attending sporting events, special events and other public gatherings in The Forum, on the other hand. Such service is authorized only on a day when there is such an event or gathering at The Forum. Unless otherwise provided by further order of this Commission, the operating authority granted by this ordering paragraph shall expire on August 11, 1969.

2. The Gray Line Tours Company is authorized to charge for service rendered under ordering paragraph 1 of this order the following round trip fares:

3. While operations are conducted under the authority of ordering paragraph 1 of this order, The Gray Line Tours Company is authorized to put in effect the timetable set forth in Exhibit 83 in consolidated Applications Nos. 49177 and 49980 and by this reference made a part hereof.

4. In providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant, The Gray Line Tours Company, shall comply with and observe the following service regulations. Failure so to do may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted. Applicant is placed on notice that, if it accepts the certificate of public convenience and necessity herein granted, it will be required, among other things, to comply with and observe the safety rules of the California Highway Patrol, the rules and other regulations of the Commission's General Order No. 98-A and insurance requirements of the Commission's General Order No. 101-B.
- (b) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file tariffs and timetables, in triplicate, in the Commission's office.
- (c) The tariff and timetable filings shall be made effective not earlier than the date of the effective date of this order and shall be concurrent with the establishment of service herein authorized.
- (d) The tariff and timetable filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs and timetables set forth in the Commission's General Orders Nos. 79 and 98-A.
- (e) Applicant shall maintain its accounting records on a calendar year basis in conformance with the applicable Uniform System of Accounts or Chart of Accounts as prescribed or adopted by this Commission and shall file with the Commission, on or before March 31 of each year, an annual report of its operations in such form, content, and number of copies as the Commission, from time to time, shall prescribe.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
