O R D E R

The City of San Bernardino is hereby authorized to reconstruct a crossing at separated grades of Meridian Avenue under the track of Southern Pacific Company, in San Bernardino, San Bernardino County, at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit B) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6T-54.17-B. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with.

Applicant requests immediate authority in order to prevent costly delays in the construction schedule of the project.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
